Looking for something even more customised? We can develop an entirely new surface – either using your own materials or carefully selected natural raw materials. This process is more time-intensive, involves several steps, and includes development costs.

STEP BY STEP TO YOUR CUSTOM-MADE SURFACE:



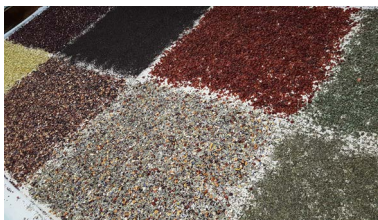
1. IDEA & CONSULTATION

How should your surface look?
We define the appearance, scent, texture, and intended use.
You will receive a cost estimate for product development.



2. MATERIAL TESTING & -SOURCING

We check the feasibility of using your own residual production materials or new raw materials and create an initial test panel.



3. TEST PANEL & SELECTION

You receive a test panel with up to 8 variations on your chosen backing material, including formula development.
(R&D costs: EUR 2,400)



4. SAMPLES & REFERENCE

The sample panels (approx. 2,950 x 1,200 mm) will be sent to you by post. A reference piece remains with us to ensure precise reproduction.



5. PRODUCTION & COMPLETION

Once approved, we manufacture your custom surface – available as sheet or roll material.
